
What has AGGS FoMSF done to address this?

As President, I wrote a direct letter to Sir Graham Brady, the MP of Altrincham and Sale West, expressing my disappointment in the UK's attitude and urging him to this issue rectify by announcing in the House of Commons the urgency with which the UK must make the additional donations.

I have received a letter from both Sir Graham and Rt Hon. Andrew Mitchell MP, Minister for Development and Africa, which describes the ways the £1 billion, donated by the UK, will be distributed and used to deliver emergency medical supplies to aid in the fight against the global pandemics of: HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis (TB) and malaria.
