What has MSF done to address this?

An MSF convoy of 14 trucks entered northwest Syria on 19th February, arriving from Türkiye through the Hammam border crossing point. This first convoy carried 1,296 tents destined to families (of five people or more) left homeless by the earthquakes and 1,296 winter kits to insulate the tents from the cold.

In recent days, two MSF trucks from Beirut have reached the city of Tartus, in Syria.

The trucks supplied 35 cubic metres of medical kits and around 50 cubic metres of essential items, including surgical and trauma kits, hygiene kits, shelters, blankets and water treatment units, to the Syrian Arab Red Crescent (SARC) in Tartus, to assist people affected by the earthquakes.

This will be the first MSF donation since the earthquake in areas where their teams are not present. MSF stands ready to provide care to people impacted by the earthquakes in the affected governorates: Idlib, Latakia, Aleppo and Hama.

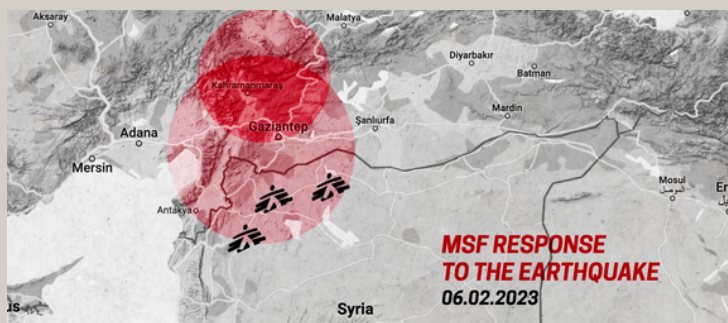
We emptied our emergency stocks in three days, donating nearly 12 tons of surgical equipment, dressing and medicines to hospitals.
